Grant proposals may be submitted for projects, activities, books, equipment, supplies, or other items that enhance the educational experience of students at Lineweaver Elementary. Preference may be given to requests that benefit a larger number of students or provide school-wide access.

- All requests will first be reviewed by the principal to ensure the proposal is appropriate, aligns with school needs, and to determine whether other funding sources may be available.
- The PTO Board will then review the request to confirm that sufficient funds are available. Eligible requests will be presented for a vote at the next General Membership Meeting .
- Any items purchased or funded by the Lineweaver PTO will become the property of Lineweaver Elementary.

Describe Project / Item to Be Purchased *

1. 25 straw bales to provide seating in Lineweaver Garden Space
2. Supplies for Smoothie Bike activity at Fall Festival

Cost *

1. Straw bales were \$5 each at San Xavier Co-op last school year. Ms. Metzler will call to confirm on Tuesday, September 8. We are requesting 25 which comes to a total of \$125. Last year the bales purchased were not charged tax. 2. Using a smoothie recipe provided by the Food Literacy Lab at Manzo Elementary (who is loaning us the bike), calculations were made to create 10 blenders-full of smoothie which allows a total of 60 kids to participate. They are providing 2 pitchers so one can be rinsed while the other is used. They are also providing several sleeves (100 cups each) of 6 oz serving cups. 2 gallons OJ (Frys): \$12.00 20 bananas (Frys) \$13.00 5 lbs. frozen fruit (Frys): \$24.00 10 lbs. ice (Frys): \$2.50 Total including tax: \$60.00

What Learning / School Objectives does this address? *

1. Seating in the Lineweaver Garden will allow for small groups and classes to have a place to sit during their investigations in the garden. Seats will be an inviting and functional addition.

2. Student powered smoothie bike allows participants to see first hand how their energy can be used to generate electricity, resulting in a yummy and healthy snack.

Additional Information

1. Mr. Wiley Hundertmark from TUSD/U of A School Gardens program is willing to coordinate picking up the 25 bales from San Xavier Co-op and deliver them to Lineweaver Garden. He is willing to charge his personal credit card with a guarantee that he will be reimbursed by Lineweaver PTO.

2. Jennifer Metzler is willing to purchase items for smoothie bike and asks to be reimbursed. Ecology Club is willing to test it out on Thursday, Nov. 12, the day before Fall Festival.
